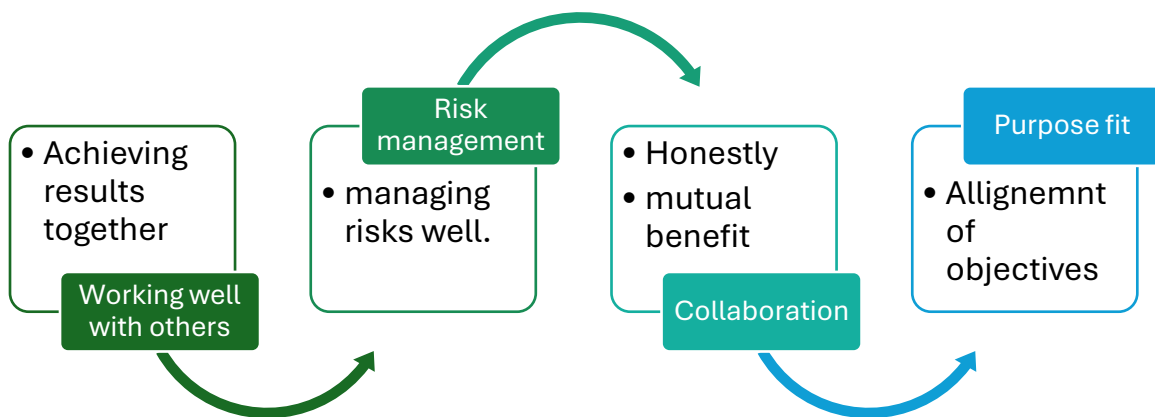


Figure 1: Our Partnership approach


