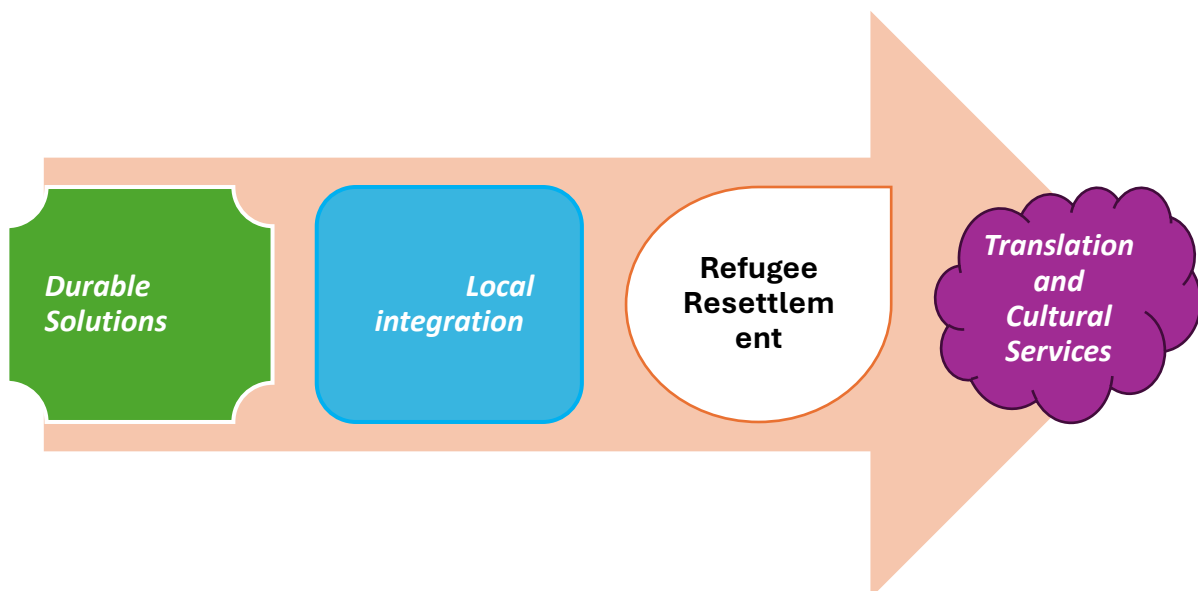


Figure 1 Abdulahi Consulting Durable Solutions thematic work

Durable Solutions

Displacement affected populations have the rights to end their displacement and associated vulnerabilities. Durable solutions are long term solutions to address displacement for Internally displaced persons or refugees to rebuild their lives and are no longer need protection assistance and care from the hosting societies or the state.

According to the [Inter-Agency Standing Committee \(IASC\) Framework](#), a durable solution is achieved when internally displaced persons (IDPs) no longer have specific assistance and protection needs linked to their displacement, and can enjoy their human rights without discrimination on account of their displacement.

Abdulahi Consulting agrees to this categorisation in principle and advocates the inherent rights of the displaced to attain the ultimate protection outcomes and end their displacement. we work towards this objective in line with our core principles, mission and values and our moto

Our local integration work is comprehensive and addresses key gaps in refugee and IDP integration in crisis and conflict affected settings.

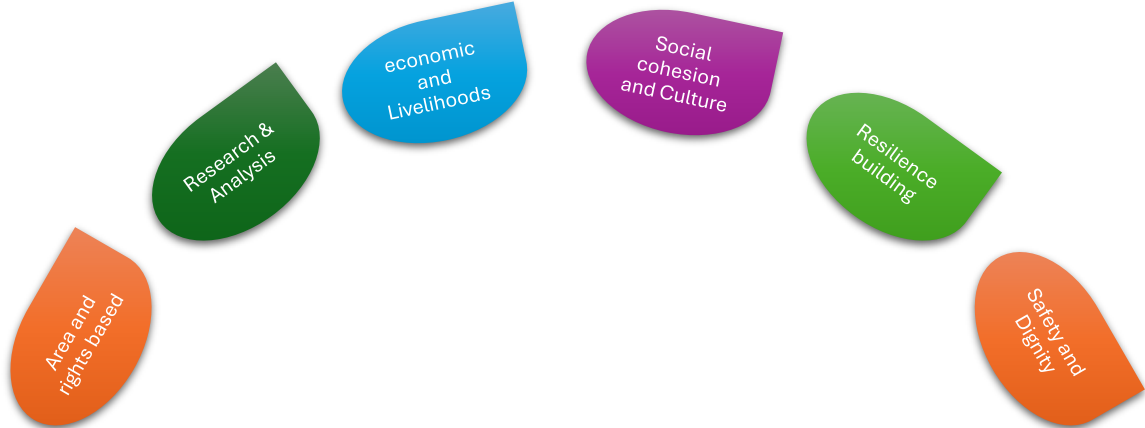


Figure 2 Local integration thematic work

We contribute our specialised expertise in local integration, area-based localisation, and the resettlement of refugees, asylum seekers, and international protection applicants within Ireland

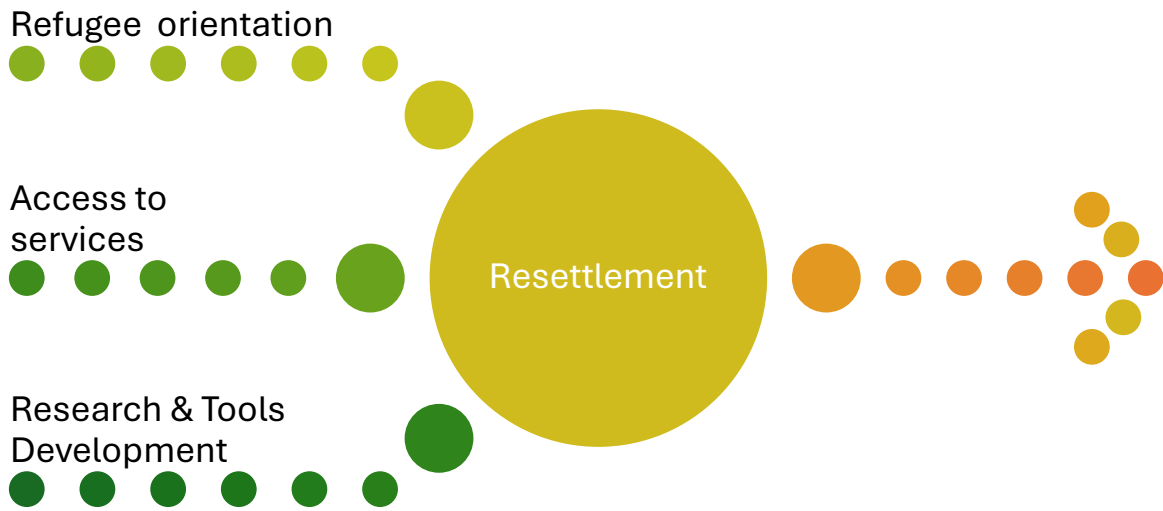


Figure 3 Abdulahi Consulting resettlement work

Translation and Cultural Services

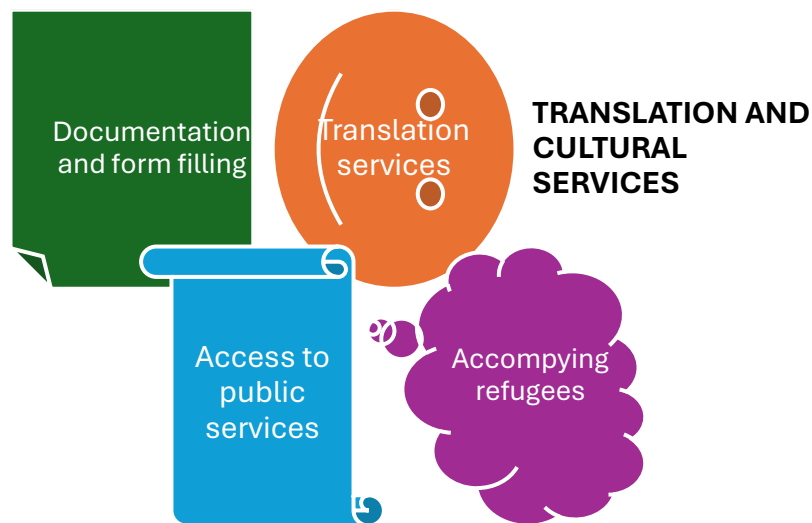


Figure 4: Cultural and translation services

We accompany them in accessing such services and offer documentation support as many migrant need support in filling application forms for instance, while maintaining integrity, privacy and confidentiality. We offer interpretation services for migrants and asylum seekers in public services such as in health settings, immigration and so on.

Other Thematic Areas

In theme 1: Education and youth, we address client needs related to Education in Emergencies (EiE) and youth in displacement settings, focusing on Access to education, school needs assessments, teaching and learning as well Technical and Vocational skills (TVET) and livelihoods for Youth. We also support Youth job placement through the Erasmus + in Europe.

In Theme 2: Durable solutions, we address key solutions in any displacement settings in conformity with IASC (inter-Agency Standing committee) guidelines for durable solutions. This include but is not limited to Resettlement, Local integration and return of Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) to places of origin as we aim to end displacement and address key gaps through social cohesion strengthening, resilience building and promoting self-reliance.
